Purpose	The Purpose of this policy is to define the position and requirements for the Association Board Member-at-Large.	
Section	The Association Board adopted the following policy:	
1.0	Members-at-Large will follow all policies of the State Association Board	
2.0	The Member-at-Large will be elected by a vote of his or her respective Chapter membership and is expected to represent both the Association and the Chapter membership to which he or she is elected. The Member-at-Large will be an elected position and a voting member on the Association Board. Directors but will not be an elected member or a voting member of the Chapter Board of Directors.	
3.0	<p>Any individual is eligible to be nominated and elected as a Member-at-Large Director provided the individual:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personally, agrees to be nominated • Is a member of the Association, and in good standing with their respective Chapter • Has been a CESA member for at least one year • Is able to attend and fully participate in meetings of the Association • Is willing to accept assigned areas of responsibility, and commit time on Association work • Agrees to adhere to the policies of the Association, and dutifully represent the Association • Follows the Expectations and Duties of the Association Board Policy • Can attend the CESA Annual Conference and Training, in person, if not in person must be able to attend via video conferencing for opening ceremonies and State Board meeting which has been called fireside chat or all members meeting. • —MALs are not allowed to miss 2 conferences in a row. Justification for this is the MAL is not a member of the chapter board, but the State Board and it is imperative they are available for the membership.
